**Option 1:** Using the information form ELA Packet D and information from the WV DHHR, CDC and WHO to create a PSA poster on 8.5X11 size. The poster should be in the format of PSA. Posters may be hung up in the bathrooms at the return of school. You may create this by hand, with paper, markers, colored, pencils, ect, or on the computer using Word, Paint or another program similar. **Please do not use online poster design programs.** Use below Table to ensure you have all requirements.

Title	Title is displayed long enough to read; font and size is easy to read.	
Pictures/ Graphics	Pictures and graphics are attractive, vibrantly colored, clear and relevant	
Tagline	PSA contains a memorable and catchy tagline that aligns with the topic and permeates with viewers	
Facts	PSA contains a neatly written, interesting, researched, accurate fact about the importance of handwashing.	
Statistics	PSA contains a neatly written, interesting, researched, accurate statistic the importance of handwashing	
Visual Clarity	PSA has an excellent design and layout and is neat and easy to understand the content	
Creativity	PSA is one-of-a-kind, inspirational and draws the viewers to it and is not plagiarized	
Reference	Clearly provides a link to CDC or WHO for more information about hygiene.	
Conventions	PSA has excellent spelling, grammar, capitalization and punctuation

**Option 2:** Create a card for (Mother’s Day -May 10<sup>th</sup>, Father’s Day June 21<sup>st</sup>, Birthday, Thinking of You, Miss You or Hope to see you soon) You may only use the type of card once for a grade. You may create this by hand, with paper, markers, colored, pencils, ect, or on the computer using Word, Paint or another program similar. **Please do not use online card creators.** Use below Table to ensure you have all requirements.

Part of Card	Requirement	Check Off
Front	Nice Design with Title of Card (One of the examples)	
Inside Left	Blank	
Inside Right	Nice Saying of at least 2 or 3 lines	
Back	Include a small -- by: your name and personal logo design or art work.	
Fold	Top Fold or Side Fold (Card must open. It will be considered a flyer/poster if it doesn’t fold and look like a card.	
Spelling	Make sure you check for spelling mistakes	

**Option 3** Read 4 of the 5 days each week for 30 minutes each day and write a quick summary each day using summary guidelines below. You may read anything you would like, preferably something technology based, or Digital Multimedia, Publication Design. Summary should be written a paragraph form with at least 4-6 sentences.

Summary guidelines are as follows:

- Name of Article or Book, if online provide link.
- What it was about?
- 2 likes & 2 Dislikes
- Something you learned.
